Tips for Donating Food to Our Pantry:

- Ensure to check expiration dates as we cannot distribute expired or opened food.
- Kindly bring donations during our operational hours and avoid leaving them outside.
- We are unable to subdivide large bags or boxes of food, so consider practicality in your donations.
- Think about what items would contribute to multiple nutritious meals for individuals or families in need.
- Apart from food, we also accept toiletries, cleaning supplies, paper products, wipes, and diapers which cannot be purchased with food stamps.
- Consider asking for a wish list from the food pantry to include these essential items in your weekly shopping list.

Tips for Donating Clothing and Household Items to the Thrift Store:

- Prior to donating, check stored boxes to ensure items are in good condition, especially due to the southern heat and critter concerns.
- Assess the sellability of your items as the proceeds from thrift store sales financially support our ministry.
- Items with stains, holes, or damages can be donated in a labeled "recycle" bag.
- Contact us beforehand for large item donations to ensure acceptance.
- Due to limited space, we process donations gradually, sorting and pricing them promptly.

Tips for Monetary donations to our Ministry:

 Monetary donations can be dropped off at our reception desk, mailed to our P.O. Box or made through our giving portal on our website or through PayPal.
